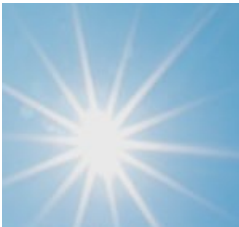

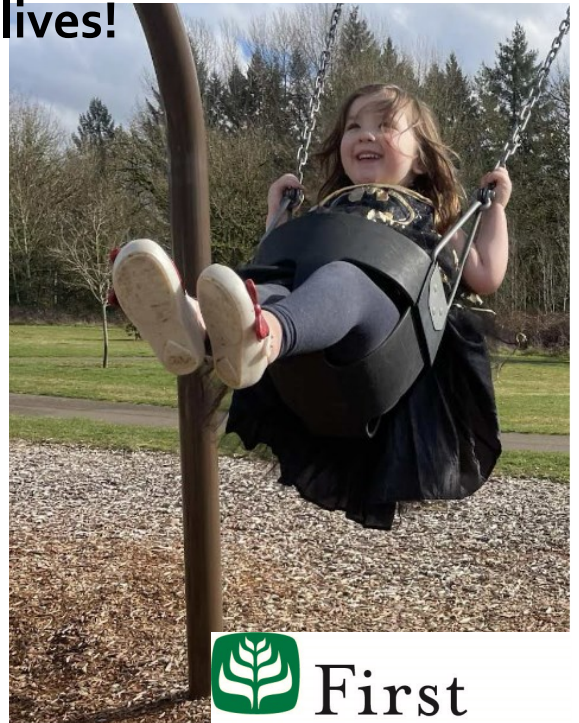
Chehalem Parenting Connection with Community Funding are making a difference in children's lives!
